Huckleberry Teen Health Program (HTHP) is a comprehensive health promotion and youth development program serving at-risk Marin County youth ages 12-21. HTHP provides free healthcare, counseling, and support services (including workshops) in a teen-friendly environment. In collaboration with the Marin County Department of Health and Human Services, HTHP provides Teen Tuesday Health drop-in clinic every Tuesday afternoon from 1:30 to 4:30 p.m., offering free health services to teenagers. These services include health education, pregnancy testing and options counseling, HIV and other STI testing, male and female exams, short-term counseling, and case management.
